







Maryland's Top 5 Agricultural Exports

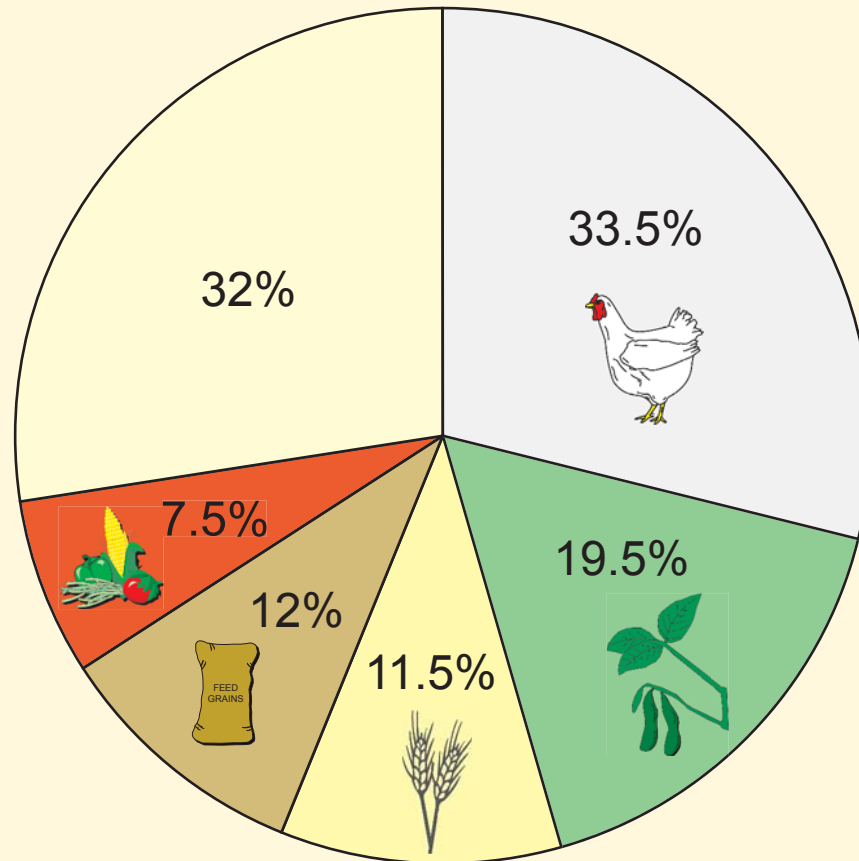


Export - A commodity or product produced or grown in Maryland and then sold to and consumed by other states or counties.

Agricultural Exports bring in \$200,000,000 annually.

This total accounts for 14% of all farm cash receipts.

Poultry - domesticated birds, such as chickens, turkeys, ducks, or geese, that are raised for meat or eggs.

Soybeans - an oilseed crop, that is used for the production of cooking oils, protein meals for livestock, and improving soils.

Wheat - a cereal grain that is ground to produce breadstuffs and pasta.

Feed Grains - any of several grains most commonly used for livestock feed, including corn, grain sorghum, oats, rye, and barley.

Vegetables - a plant grown for an edible part, such as cucumbers, broccoli, peppers, and lettuce.
